

Green Mountain Club Seasonal Trail Crew Position Description

Position Title: Long Trail Patrol member

Direct Supervisor: Dave Hardy (Director of Trail Programs).

Length of this agreement: June to October. End date negotiable.

Weekly Stipend: \$366 to \$380

These are untenured seasonal positions with a defined end date. An Americorps EAP award may be available.

Position Description:

- Patrol members are responsible for performing a variety of construction and maintenance tasks as enumerated below:

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| 1. Trail blazing | 7. Bridge construction |
| 2. Trail brushing | 8. Routine shelter maintenance |
| 3. Blowdown removal | 9. Shelter repair & construction |
| 4. Construction of erosion control devices | 10. Outhouse repair & construction |
| 5. Trail treadway rehabilitation | 11. Sign making & installation |
| 6. Trail construction | 12. Safety |

Individual crews will normally concentrate on several of the above items. Each Patrol member receives daily service assignments from the Trail Crew Leader.

- Patrol members are expected to become proficient with the various tools utilized by the Long Trail Patrol.
- Patrol are responsible for sharing all North Barn, Danby camp and Back Forty chores with all field staff.
- Compliance with Seasonal Personnel Policy
- Americorps members eligible for EAP award will complete timesheets for each 2-week pay period that shall include a half hour lunch break each work day exceeding 4 hours in length. The ½ hour lunch does not count toward your total Americorps hours.
- Other tasks as assigned by the Director of Trail Programs not in conflict with National Service requirements including Prohibited Activities per your Member Service Agreement.

Prohibited Activities: Staff fulfilling a term of service for an Americorps EAP award will adhere to the Service Agreement and will not engage in any of the activities detailed in Clause VI of the Member Service Agreement.
